Why is it called Hirome Market?

From Hiroto Shigeaki Fukao, the distinguished chief retainer of the Tosa Yamauchi family

There was a distinguished chief retainer named Hiroto Shigeaki Fukao, who served the Tosa Yamauchi family for four generations — from the 12th lord Toyosuke to the 15th lord Toyonobu.

His residence once stood on the very site where today's Hirome Market is located.

After the Meiji Restoration, when his estate disappeared, the area came to be affectionately known as "Hirome Yashiki" (Hirome Residence).

ne market later took its name from this history and was called Hirome Marke

The name also carries another meaning: to "hiromeru" — to spread and share — the culture, cuisine, spirit, and warmth of the people of Kōchi.
